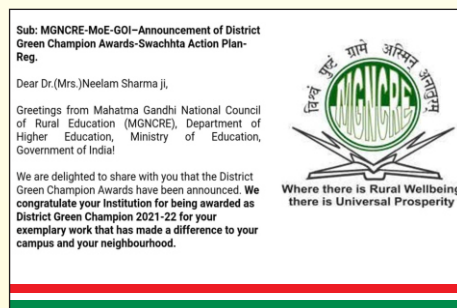

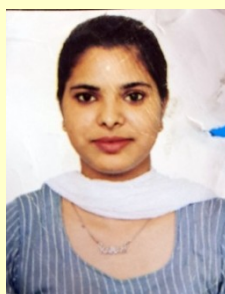

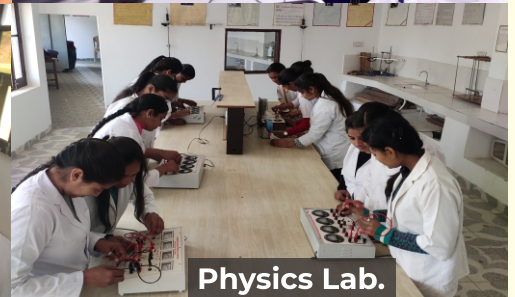

Activities of NCC

NCC unit (Army Wing) of our college is working under 4 PB GIRLS BN NCC PATIALA. The NCC aims at developing character, comradeship, discipline, a secular outlook, the spirit of adventure and ideas of selfless service amongst young citizens. Our Associated NCC Officer Lt. Veerpal Kaur has been conducting all the activities that playing a very constructive role in the overall development of cadets to inculcate "Unity and Discipline" in the character of cadets that is the motto of NCC. The students of 1st semester of any stream have the option to enroll in NCC after clearing the common entrance test and interview conducted by NCC unit. Enrolled students are required to attend two parades of three periods each per week.

Rules & Regulations

The College is affiliated to Punjabi University, Patiala and follows the semester system. The college working hours, teaching schedules, vacations, examination schedule and eligibility to appear in the examination are as prescribed by the university and are followed by the college.

1. College lays special emphasis on the maintenance of discipline and proper decorum in & outside the classrooms.
2. Use of mobile Phones in college campus by the students is allowed with the written permission of their parents & Principal. Otherwise a fine of Rs. 500 would be levied on any student caught violating this rule.
3. Fine of Rs.50/- will be levied if students will not wear white uniform with blue dupatta on Monday Assembly & on all the college functions. In winter should be in maroon color.
4. Application for leave will only be entertained only if it bears the signature of parents/guardians and the tutor.
5. Medical certificate duly signed by doctor, has to be attached with the application for sick leave for more than three days.
6. Students are expected to be polite to one another and show courtesy to the employees of the college.
7. Day scholars are not allowed to visit the hostel except with the written permission of teachers/ warden in any special issue.
8. Annual parking fee for cycle is Rs. 300/- & for scooter Rs.600/- which is submitted by the student.
9. No students is allowed to correspond at the college address & meet the quests without the permission of the Principal.
10. No student is allowed to use college phone without prior permission & no member of the college is allowed to indulge in anti-institution, anti-social, anti-national activities.
11. Attendance at the morning assembly is compulsory for the students.
12. Students are not allowed to leave the college till the 6th period is over.
13. Students must be in possession of their identity cards.
14. Students must develop the habit of forming queue.
15. Writing on walls or furniture is prohibited.
16. Students should maintain cleanliness in the campus.
17. Observe punctuality & regularity.
18. Vacant periods should be utilized in reading books, magazines & newspaper.
19. Read the Notice board daily.
20. No fee concession will be given to those students, who will get compartment/re-appear in their lower examination.
21. Out of total 5% seats are reserved for SC students, 2% for OBC students and 2% for disabled students. If no student in these categories then seats will be open for general candidates.

Library Rules

Authorized Members:

1. Use of college library is restricted to the students enrolled for current session.
2. Members of the college faculty and staff respectively.

Conditions for using library

1. The college librarian shall issue a library card to each authorized user.
2. The authorized user shall be required to produce library card as and when needed by the library staff.
3. In loss of library card ,the students shall report the same to library immediately.
4. The use of library card is not transferable to another user.

Borrowing Facility

1. The timing of borrowing books from college library will be as per schedule given by the Library Management Committee.
2. While wanting to borrow and return books, the students are expected to come in queues and get served one by one without creating any noise at the circulation counter.
3. Every student is entitled to borrow two books at time for duration of 15 days. Students who fail to return the book on due date (16th day) are liable to be charged fine of Rs.5/ per day per book.
4. A borrower who loses an item shall have to deposit the item itself. if the lost book belongs to a set and is not available separately, the member shall have to replace the whole set or pay double the price of the set.
5. Dictionaries, current issues of periodicals/magazines and reference books are available only for consultation and are not ordinarily issued.
6. Taking books out of library without authorization, marking and underlining or in any way disfiguring and tampering books or library property is a misdemeanor which may lead to withdrawal of library privileges, or in serious case, heavy fine and disciplinary action.
7. All members are advised to check the books for any defects before getting them issued. The last borrower shall be responsible for any damage to the book/periodical etc. unless it has been pointed out at the time of issue.
8. The college Librarian has the authority to recall any books before due date.

Conduct in Library

1. Talking and consumption of food is strictly prohibited in the library.
2. The students are not expected to bring any personal reading material inside and keep it in the locker at library entrance.
3. Use of cell phone or any noisy substance is strictly banned & the violation of same shall evoke fine as per college rules.
4. The library accepts no responsibility for personal belongings left or lost in the library building.



Hostel Facilities

The Institute has a separate hostel for girls. The hostel accommodates upto 100 girls. Hostel also includes the features like Television Halls, Mess, Desert Coolers, Uninterrupted Power & Water Supply, ATM Services, Security arrangements, Medical Facility, STD/ISD & Basic Need Shop with in the campus.

Note: One block of Hostel allotted for working women from this session.

HOSTEL RULES

A: GENERAL

1. Any meeting to be held in the hostel premises should have the prior approval of the Principal/Hostel Warden.
2. All the boarders shall vacate the hostel rooms before they leave for the vacation so that the annual repairs and white washing are carried out. All the hostel property issued to the students should be returned to the hostel warden/clerk before the students leave their rooms. They will be held responsible for any loss.
3. The mess arrangements will be under the directions of the warden
4. Student who wants to be a member of this homely atmosphere is supposed to fill a separate form with a clear reference to any 4 person (Parents/Guardians/Relatives/etc.) who are to pay visit to the ward during the session.
5. Their attested photographs must be submitted to the students.
6. Forms of two real sisters will be separated.
7. Mention the address and telephone no. of Local Relative/Guardians who are to be visited by the ward.

B: Allotment

1. The room allotment shall be made by the warden.
2. The students must be personally present at the time of allotment of rooms.
3. The students can choose their room mates and make request for allotment accordingly.
4. The boarder shall not be entitled to retain accommodation in the hostel beyond her normal period of study.
5. No Boarder is allowed to change her room without the permission of the warden.

C: Leave Rules

1. Leave sanctioned for absence from the college does not mean leave from the hostel.
2. The student should get the leave sanctioned personally from hostel warden before it is availed.
